1. To be eligible for these awards the ACD must be registered with the CKC (ERN or PEN) and the owner must be a member of the ACDCC
2. The dog must also have a minimum of a Started title in at least one organization.
3. The number of points awarded is determined by the number of dogs entered according to the Scale of Points. (shown left).
4. Points shall only be awarded to dogs receiving qualifying scores. There shall be no differentiation in working any allowed stock type except no more than 25% of the points shall be on ducks.
5. Points can be attained at CKC, AHBA, ASCA or approved Stock Dog trials held in Canada, on any course type (arena, ranch or tending)
6. Any dog winning High In Trial from the Advanced class will be awarded double points up to a maximum of 5 per trial

Top Herding ACD of the Year

This award will be given to the dog that earns the most points in fiscal year (Nov. 1 to Oct. 31). The dog must be OWNED by an ACDCC member, but not necessarily handled by one. There is no restriction on the birthplace (Canada or Elsewhere) or the breeder. The dog must have a CKC registration number, an Event Registration number (ERN) or a Performance Event Registration number (PEN).

Top ACD Herding Handler of the Year

This award will be given to the ACDCC member handler that has accumulated the most points in the fiscal year (Nov. 1 to Oct. 31). All points earned must be done on Australian Cattle Dogs. The handler may or may not own necessarily own such dogs, however points earned must have been earned by at least two (2) dogs.

Top ACD Junior Handler of the Year

This award will be given to the ACDCC member handler under the age of 18, that has accumulated the most points in the fiscal year (Nov. 1 to Oct. 31). All points earned must be done on Australian Cattle Dogs. The handler may or may not own necessarily own such dogs, however points earned must have been earned by at least two (2) dogs.

The Top ACD Herding Breeder of the Year

This award will be given to the ACDCC member who is the breeder or co-breeder on record that has accumulated the most combined points in the fiscal year (Nov. 1 to Oct. 31) on at least 2 dogs.
